



END USER LICENSE AGREEMENT FOR WORLD BUREAU DATABASE IMPORTANT- READ CAREFULLY

This end user license agreement (EULA) is a legal agreement between you (either as an individual or as a single entity) and the copyright owner of the database contained on the CD ROM provided, identified above (DATABASE), World Bureau of Metal Statistics (the COPYRIGHT OWNER).

Dear Sir/Madam,

As you will see from the enclosed License (copy to be signed and returned), we are taking our Copyright very seriously in distributing this database. Before signing the License and agreeing to its terms, I would like to draw your attention to the following points:

- Section 103 ss(1) states that an infringement of a right conferred by Chapter IV is actionable as a breach of statutory duty owed to the person entitled to the right.
- Section 107 of the ACT

107.—(1) A person commits an offence who, without the licence of the copyright owner—

(a) makes for sale or hire, or

(b) imports into the United Kingdom otherwise than for his private and domestic use, or

(c) possesses in the course of a business with a view to committing any act infringing the copyright, or

(d) in the course of a business —

(i) sells or lets for hire, or

(ii) offers or exposes for sale or hire, or

(iii) exhibits in public, or

(iv) distributes, or

(e) distributes otherwise than in the course of a business to such an extent as to affect prejudicially the owner of the copyright,

an article which is, and which he knows or has reason to believe is, an infringing copy of a copyright work.

(4) A person guilty of an offence under subsection (1)(a), (b), (d)(iv) or (e) is liable—

(a) on summary conviction to imprisonment for a term not exceeding six months or a fine not exceeding the statutory maximum, or both;

(b) on conviction on indictment to a fine or imprisonment for a term not exceeding two years, or both.

(5) A person guilty of any other offence under this section is liable on summary conviction to imprisonment for a term not exceeding six months or a fine not exceeding level 5 on the standard scale, or both.

- Section 110 of the ACT extends these provisions to the body corporate.
